

SCRUNCHY NAME TAG

A fun way to do name tags for parties for your kids!

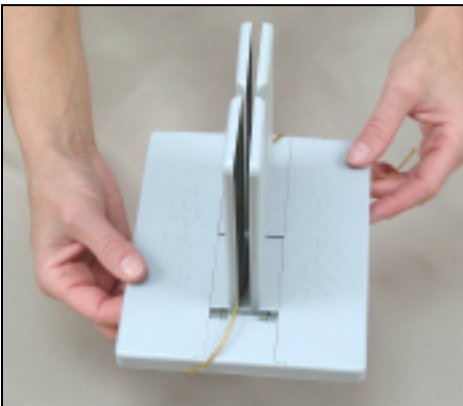


INGREDIENTS

- 24" length of Bowdabra Bow Wire
- 6" pieces of 6"-wide Metallic Scrunch (similar scrunchy ribbon, tulle or cellophane can be substituted)
- 1" wooden disc
- 1 clasp pin

PUTTING IT TOGETHER...

Use colors and silks that compliment your Thanksgiving decor!



1. Cut a 24" piece of bow tie. Fold it in half and lay it into the Bowdabra



2. Create a Scrunchy Bow* using the 6" length of Metallic Scrunch Ribbon. Scrunch the ribbon into the Bowdabra. It will pile up like an accordion. Scrunch down the ribbon with the Bowdabra wand. Grasp the loose ends of the bow tie and feed it through the loop. Pull the bow tie tightly while the bow is still in the Bowdabra. Take the bow out of the Bowdabra. Separate the two loose ends of the bow tie and bring them around to the back of the bow. Tie a knot. Trim the ends. Fluff the bow.



3. Using a magic marker, write or print the child's name on the 1" wooden disc. Using your glue gun, place a large dab of glue on the backside of the wooden disc. Glue the wooden disc to the 'right side' of the Scrunchy Bow (the side without the knot). Make certain that the wooden disc is centered within the Scrunchy Bow.



4. Using your glue gun, cover the back of the clasp pin with glue. Position the clasp pin on the back of the Scrunchy Bow.



5. Do a final fluffing
