

Valentine Napkin Holders



Materials Needed:

- Mini Bowdabra®
- Bowdabra® Bow Wire
- Ribbon
- Unfinished Wooden Holders
- Adhesive Gems

- Begin by placing adhesive gems all around the unfinished napkin holders.
- **To make the bows for the napkin holders:** Cut a 24" piece of Bowdabra Bow Wire and fold it in half. Lay it into the Mini Bowdabra. You'll have a loop at one end and two loose pieces at the opposite end.
- Cut three pieces of scrap ribbon 5" in length. Dovetail all three pieces of ribbon. To dovetail both ends: fold the ribbon in half lengthwise. Position your scissors at the folded edge of the ribbon and cut the end at a 45° angle.
- Lay the ribbon into the Mini Bowdabra.
- Scrunch ribbon down with the Mini Bowdabra Wand.
- While the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra, thread the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire through the loop at the other end.
- Pull the Bowdabra Bow Wire tightly while the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra.
- Gently pull the bow out of the Mini Bowdabra. Separate the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire and bring them around to the back of the bow. To tie off the bow, pinch the Bowdabra Bow Wire securely against the bow. Twist the bow 4 to 6 times in a clockwise direction.
- Fluff bow and tie it onto the napkin holder. The bow should be placed on the top of the napkin holder. Spiral the remaining Bowdabra Bow Wire with a pencil for fun ringlets.
