

# Valentine Bracelet



## Materials Needed:

- Mini Bowdabra®
- Bowdabra® Bow Wire
- Plastic Craft Lace
- Lanyard Hook
- Heart Beads
- Ribbon

- Using plastic craft lace form a small loop at the end and then knot it. Attach a lanyard hook onto the end of the loop.
- Thread heart beads onto the craft lace.
- Tie the other end of the craft lace into a knot and then form a loop. Thread the excess craft lace down into the center of the beads.
- **To make the flower bow for the bracelet.** Cut a 24” piece of Bowdabra Bow Wire and fold it in half. Lay it into the Mini Bowdabra. You’ll have a loop at one end and two loose pieces at the opposite end.
- To form the petals for the flower bow cut the ends of the ribbon at an angle. Cut several different lengths of ribbon.
- Place the petals into the Mini Bowdabra layering largest to smallest at all different angles.
- Scrunch ribbon down with the Mini Bowdabra Wand.
- While the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra, thread the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire through the loop at the other end.
- Pull the Bowdabra Bow Wire tightly while the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra.
- Gently pull the bow out of the Mini Bowdabra. Separate the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire and bring them around to the back of the bow. To tie off the bow, pinch the Bowdabra Bow Wire securely against the bow. Twist the bow 4 to 6 times in a clockwise direction.
- Fluff your bow and attach the it to the center of the bracelet. Spiral the Bowdabra Bow Wire with a pencil for fun ringlets.
