

Valentine Centerpiece



Materials Needed:

- Mini Bowdabra®
- Bowdabra® Bow Wire
- Ribbon
- Tamales
- Flameless Tea lights
- Glass Bowl

- Begin by filling tamale candies into a glass bowl.
- Place flameless tea light into the tamales.
- **To make the bow to set in the front of the centerpiece:** Cut a 24” piece of Bowdabra Bow Wire and fold it in half. Lay it into the Mini Bowdabra. You’ll have a loop at one end and two loose pieces at the opposite end.
- Cut three pieces of scrap ribbon 5” in length. Dovetail all three pieces of ribbon. To dovetail both ends: fold the ribbon in half lengthwise. Position your scissors at the folded edge of the ribbon and cut the end at a 45° angle.
- Lay the ribbon into the Mini Bowdabra.
- Lay festive Valentine picks into the center of the Mini Bowdabra.
- Scrunch ribbon down with the Mini Bowdabra Wand.
- While the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra, thread the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire through the loop at the other end.
- Pull the Bowdabra Bow Wire tightly while the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra.
- Gently pull the bow out of the Mini Bowdabra. Separate the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire and bring them around to the back of the bow. To tie off the bow, pinch the Bowdabra Bow Wire securely against the bow. Twist the bow 4 to 6 times in a clockwise direction.
- Fluff bow and spiral the remaining Bowdabra Bow Wire with a pencil for fun ringlets. Place in the front of the bowl.
